## PLAINTIFF-APPELLANT'S PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES TO BE RAISED

Pursuant to the Court's Docketing Order of February 23, 2015, Plaintiff-Appellant National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (NACDL) hereby submits this preliminary statement of the issues that NACDL intends to raise in this appeal:

- 1. Whether a government manual that "comprehensively covers the law, policy, and practice of prosecutors' disclosure obligations" may be withheld from the public and NACDL on the ground that it constitutes attorney work product, pursuant to § 552(b)(5) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).
- 2. Whether a government manual that "comprehensively covers the law, policy, and practice of prosecutors' disclosure obligations" may be withheld from

the public and NACDL on the ground disclosing it would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions that could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, pursuant to § 552(b)(7)(E) of FOIA.
